Girls Uniform

Summer:

- Straight-through dress of green and white check uniform material
- Bottle green shorts, skirt, or skort
- Gold polo shirt (may have green stripe on collar) (Collarless T shirts are not part of the Policy)

Winter:

- Pinafore skirt (Same as St Catherine's)
- Gold polo shirt or long sleeved skivvy
- Bottle green trousers, track pants, jeans, etc
- Bottle green jumper, hoodie, jacket, vest or year 7 jumper
- Bottle green tights in winter

(SAPSASA jumpers are NOT part of the uniform)

Boys Uniform

Summer:

- Grey or green shorts
- Gold polo shirt (may have a green stripe on collar) (Collarless T shirts are not part of the Policy)

Winter:

- Grey or green trousers, track pants, jeans, etc
- Gold polo shirt or long sleeved skivvy
- Bottle green jumper, hoodie, jacket, vest or year 7 jumper

(Note: SAPSASA jumpers are NOT part of the uniform)

Unisex Items

Footwear:

- Sandals/boots/covered shoes with flat soles
- · Grey or white socks

Sports Wear:

- Bottle green shorts, skirt or skort
- · Gold polo shirt
- White socks
- Sports shoes
- Bottle green track pants
- Bottle green jumper

Scarf:

Bottle green or gold scarf

Uniform Requirements

Hat Policy:

Bucket hats to be worn, as enforced by the Sun Smart Policy. A bucket hat is issued to each child when they commence school. Any replacements may be purchased from the front office.

Sun Smart Policy:

Children who do not have their hats with them will play in an area protected from the sun. Children will be encouraged to apply sunscreen when outdoors and use available areas of shade for outdoor play activities. Each classroom is supplied with sunscreen for student use.

Jewellery:

Watches, Medic Alerts, Studs, Sleepers and Signet Rings approved.

Rings are to be removed for safety reasons if the teacher deems this necessary.

The wearing of a single, fine, plain gold or silver necklace with a small locket or charm is acceptable. All other necklaces, bracelets and toe rings with school uniform are not allowed.

Hair:

It is recommended that all hair be tied back, off of the face while at school.

Nail Polish:

Nail polish is not to be worn with school uniform

Make Up:

Make Up is not to be worn with school uniform.

General Miscellaneous

From time to time the Parents and Friends Association take orders for polo shirts, shorts, windcheaters and rugby jumpers.

Emblems can be embroidered onto items of school uniform. Please contact Parents and Friends Association to organise.

Iron-on emblems are available from the office at school.

The Parents and Friends Association also have a second-hand cupboard, which has jumpers, shirts, skirts etc. for sale - a gold coin donation is required.

- Readymade summer and winter uniforms can be purchased from Mt Barker Uniform Shop (83983983.)
- Green and white check uniforms available from Target, Kmart and Big W
- Bottle green track pants (with a flared leg and zip-pockets) are available from Anne Boughen, at Karoonda (85783427).
- Gold polo shirts, skivvies, track pants, jumpers etc can be purchased from Big W, Target and sports stores or orders can be placed though the school from LW Reid.
- Boys' grey pants can be purchased from Grandisons at Murray Bridge, Big W, Target and Target
- The Parents and Friends regularly order through a company called L W Reid. All uniform items
 can be ordered through them. Please ask at the front office if requiring anything from them and
 an order may be placed.
- Helen Jarvis (Helen's Crafts 85772257) is an agent for L W Reid.
- Embroidery can be organised through Pictures and Stitches.
- Iron on emblems are available at the Front Office.
- A second hand uniform cupboard is situated in the Home Economics room. Items may be bought for a small donation to the Parents and Friends Association. Ask for a key at the Front office.
